Term 3 ELECTRICITY

Construct and draw series circuits using circuit symbols. Look at complete and incomplete circuits and explore reasons why a circuit may be incomplete. Explore variations within circuits and the effects of having fewer or more components. Plan and carry out an enquiry voltage experiment.

Term 4 LIGHT

Name and identify simple parts of the human eye and their function in relation to being able to see objects. Identify those light travels in straight lines, but that it can change direction if it is reflects from an object. Use opaque objects to produce shadows with different shapes. Undertake a fair test to explore whether the distance from a light source affects the size of the shadow.




Term 3 & Term 4 WORLD WAR TWO

Using a wide range of historical sources this is an overview of World War Two, to know the impact the war had on families and children both nationally and in our locality and investigate the legacy of the individuals, policy and technology that we see around us today.









Term 3 IS TECHNOLOGY A GOOD THING FOR RELIGIOUS WORLDVIEWS? (PART 1)

Explore the impact of the printing press on Christian and non-religious worldviews. Engage with the story of William Tyndale, to address philosophical concepts of 'right' and 'wrong' in relation to the use of technology by religious worldviews.

Term 4 IS TECHNOLOGY A GOOD THING FOR RELIGIOUS WORLDVIEWS? (PART 2) Consider ways in which various religious worldviews utilise technology in contemporary times. Making links with religious beliefs and values, and consider the advantages and disadvantages of using technology in religious worldviews.



Term 3 ART – DRAWING AND PAINTING


Applying knowledge of landscapes, silhouette and perspective to create a wartime masterpiece.
